The room is already in frequent use despite being re-opened for use just a couple of weeks ago. The use of the room will grow. We want to provide disabled access now so no disabled users will not be excluded.

What proof will there be of whether the project has been successful? (We will need to check that money has been well spent. To do this we will need to see proof that the project has delivered the things it set out to do. Success must take a form that we can measure, such as number of people helped.)	There will be clear proof that the money has been spent on the installation of the stair lift.  Real success will, of course, be when disabled young people who want to join activities in the room are able to do so.  We are already in contact with one young person who would not currently be able to participate in the activities in the youth room due to their disabilities and this stair lift would solve that problem for them and others like them.
