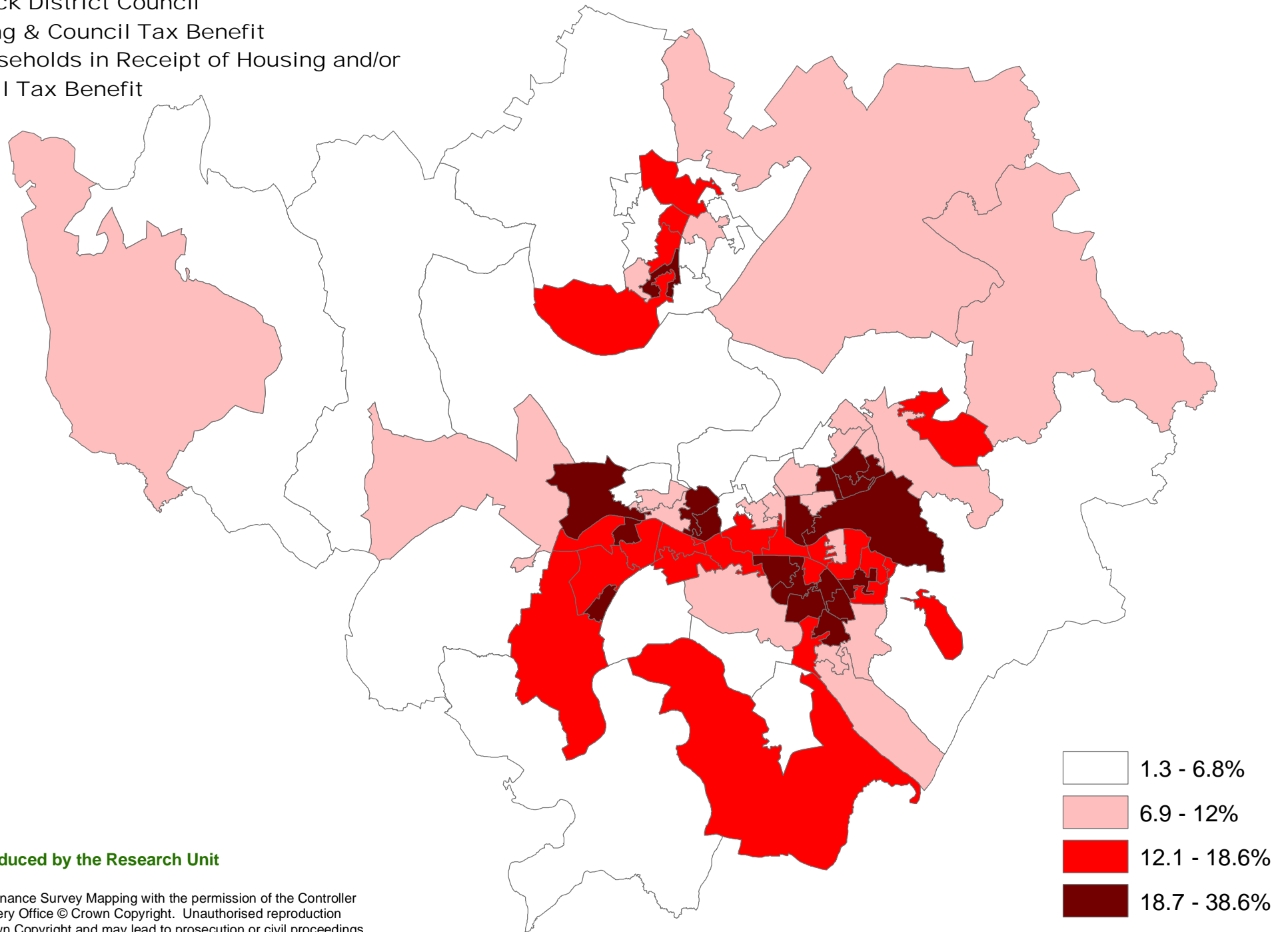


## ***Council Tax and Housing Benefits***

If an individual is on a low income or is unemployed and has low levels of savings yet is responsible for paying rent and/or council tax they may be entitled to claim housing and/or council tax benefit to help meet the costs.
