



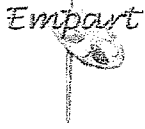

Ref: Crown Way Community Mural Project

Further to our recent discussions, please accept the following as a quote for the Crown Way Community Mural, as part of the plan for the locality agenda for Lillington.

The idea behind the mural is to consult with the local community and local young people to design and paint a mural by the Fish and Chip Shop on Crown Way that mirrors one of the Masters of art, similar to the Monet piece already designed by young people on the side of Crown Way. The mural will be designed in consultation with local residents and young people, and will be painted by young people from the estate. Young people will learn skills in photography, the history of art, teamwork, design skills, painting and community development.

The lead artist for this work will be Tony Dixon, who has recently worked with young people in Lillington to develop, design and paint the Olympic Mural at Lillington Youth Club.
