

Warwick District Local Plan 1996 – 2011 Consultation on Omission Sites

Introduction

The District Council is consulting on Omission Sites arising out of the public consultation on the Warwick District Local Plan 1996 - 2011. Omission sites comprise land suggested by an objector as an allocation, land where an alternative use to that proposed in the plan is suggested and sites where a material change to the boundary of a site allocated in the plan is suggested.

Objections proposing Omission Sites have been received at first and revised deposit stages and are available for inspection at the Council's Office at Riverside House, Milverton Hill, Royal Leamington Spa, as part of the overall representation documentation for the Local Plan Inquiry. These Omission Sites will be considered through the Inquiry. The final decision as to whether the Omission Sites should be included in the Local Plan will be made by an Independent Inspector, whose report will be binding on the Council. To help inform the Inspector's decisions, the Council is consulting upon the Omission Sites which are set out in this document.

How to Object to or Support an Omissions Site

Representations on these sites should be made in writing to the Council on the Omission Sites Consultation Form. This is available on the Council's website and at each of the locations where this document is deposited. A copy is also bound into the back of this document and can be photocopied.

Representations made at this stage must relate only to the Omission Sites, not other aspects of the Local Plan. All submissions will be passed to the Inspector who will deal with them as written representations.

Referencing Your Objection or Support

There are 64 Omission Site Maps (referenced 1-64) in this document, illustrating a total of 101 Omission Sites. Each Omission Site has a name (indicated on the schedule of Omission Sites), a description and an objection reference number (eg. 365/AA). The description and objection reference number are shown on the map key.

We ask that you tell us the map name and number that illustrates the Omission Site you wish to comment on. We would also like the Omission Site name (from the schedule), and its description and objection reference number. This is particularly important where there is more than one Omission Site on the relevant map (see, for example, Map 1 Warwick and Leamington).

In some cases there is more than one objection reference number given to a single Omission Site. This is where the same site and same use has been put forward by more than one objector (see, for example, Map 2: River Avon and River Leam). Where there is more than one objection reference number for a single Omission Site, it is only necessary to list the first of these.

Consultation Period

A period of six weeks is allowed for representations on the Omission Sites. This will run from **Monday 23rd January to 5.15 pm on Monday 6th March**.
