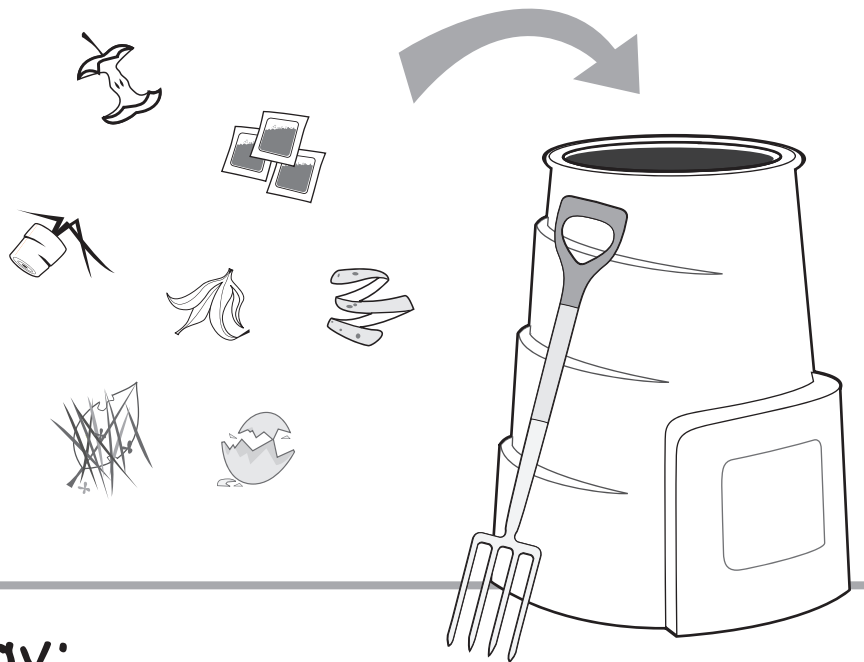


### Hot Rotting!

Chuck stuff like old teabags and apple cores in the compost bin and let them rot down. You'll get dark, earthy compost for growing new plants! This game tells you more ...









### Here's how to play:

1. Colour the sheet and stick it onto card (recycle an old cereal box).
2. Get some mates and a dice (re-use old buttons as counters).
3. Roll the dice to move your counters along the board.

You'll find things (like worms) that help make good compost. They'll speed things up. But watch out for stuff that can go wrong – squares that will send you back and slow your compost-making down.
