

Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004 Sustainable Buildings Supplementary Planning Document Adoption Statement

In accordance with Regulation 19 of the Town & Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004, notice is given that Warwick District Council formally adopted its Sustainable Buildings Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on December 19th 2008.

The SPD expands upon policies DP11 (Drainage), DP12 (Energy Efficiency) and DP13 (Renewable Energy Developments) of the Warwick District Local Plan 1996 – 2011 setting out the Council's approach to ensuring the use of renewable energy, energy efficiency and water conservation measures in new developments.
