## Fare Guide

The fares below are approximate.
If the taxi speed is below 8 mph (e.g. because of traffic or signals) during the day the fare on the meter will increase by an additional 10 p, 15 p or 20 p (depending on the tariff) for every 30 seconds (or part of 30 seconds). E.g. Stopped in traffic for $21 / 2$ minutes -50 p on tariff 1 . (See fare chart).
The maximum fare you should pay is the fare on the meter unless the journey ends outside the district boundary. Agree the fare for this type of journey before you get in the vehicle.
