# The Warwick District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2015

Made ≤C

January 2015

Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)

Warwick District ("the council"), in accordance with section 82 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007(a) ("the 2007 Act"), has undertaken a community governance review and made recommendations.

The council has decided to give effect to those recommendations and, in accordance with section 93 of the 2007 Act, has consulted with the local government electors and other interested persons and has had regard to the need to secure that community governance reflects the identities and interests of the community and is effective and convenient:

The council, in accordance with section 100 of the 2007 Act, has had regard to guidance issued under that section.

The council makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 86, 98(3), 98(4), 98(6) and 240(10) of the 2007 Act.

### Citation and commencement

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Warwick District (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2015.
  - (1) This order shall come into force on 1 April 2015.
  - (2) Article 12 (Schedule 3) shall come into force on a date given by the Boundary Commission for England following a separate Community Governance Review for these areas by said Commission.

### Interpretation

2. in this Order-

"district" means the district of Warwick;

"existing" means existing on the date this Order is made;

"map" means the map marked "Map referred to in the Warwick (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2015" and deposited in accordance with section 96(4) of the 2007 Act: and any reference to a numbered or lettered sheet is a reference to the sheet of the map which bears that number or letter;

"ordinary day of election of councillors" has the meaning given by section 37 of the Representation of the People Act 1983; and

"registration officer" means an officer appointed for the purpose of, and in accordance with, section 8 of the Representation of the People Act 1983.

#### **Effect of Order**

3. This Order has effect subject to any agreement under section 99 (agreements about incidental matters) of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 relevant to any provision of this Order.

### Calculation of budget requirement

4. For the purposes of regulation 3 of the Local Government Finance (New Parishes) (England) Regulations 2008(a) the District Council will not make changes for the financial year of 2015/2016 in relation to existing Parish Council budgets for the forthcoming financial year.

### **Election of Parish Councillors**

5. The election of all parish councillors shall be held simultaneously on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015, 2019, 2023(b). The term of office of every parish councillor elected on the ordinary day of election of councillors shall be four years.

### Numbers of parish councillors for the parish of Kenilworth

6. The number of councillors to be elected for the Kenilworth Abbey ward of the parish of Kenilworth shall be five.

### Wards of the parish and numbers of parish councillors

- 7.— The parish of Burton Green shall be divided into two wards which shall be named Burton Green (Burton Green Ward) and Burton Green (University Ward).
  - (1) Each ward shall comprise the area designated on the map 8 by reference to the name of the ward and demarcated by orange lines
  - (2) The number of councillors to be elected for the Burton Green ward shall be seven and for University ward shall be four.
- 8. The parish of Old Milverton and Blackdown shall be divided into two wards which shall be named Old Milverton (Old Milverton Ward) and Blackdown (Blackdown Ward).
  - (1) Each ward shall comprise the area designated on the map G by reference to the name of the ward and demarcated by orange lines
  - (2) The number of councillors to be elected for the Old Milverton ward shall be three and for Blackdown ward shall be two.

### Wards of the parish and numbers of parish councillors

- 9. The parish of Royal Learnington Spa shall be divided into eight wards which shall be named as set out in column (1) of Schedule 1.
  - (1) Each ward shall comprise the area of the district ward specified in respect of the ward in column (2) of that Schedule.
  - (2) The number of councillors to be elected for each ward shall be the number specified in respect of the ward in column (3) of that Schedule.

- 10. The parish of Warwick shall be divided into five wards which shall be named as set out in column (1) of Schedule 1.
  - (1) Each ward shall comprise the area of the district ward specified in respect of the ward in column (2) of that Schedule.
  - (2) The number of councillors to be elected for each ward shall be the number specified in respect of the ward in column (3) of that Schedule.

### Ward of the parish of Kenilworth and numbers of parish councillors

- 11.—The existing Queens ward of the parish of Kenilworth shall be abolished.
- (1) The parish ward shall become part of the parish ward of Kenilworth St. John's which shall be named as set out in column (5) of Schedule 2.
- (2) The ward shall comprise the area of the district ward specified in respect of the ward in column (2) of that Schedule 1.
- (3) The number of councillors to be elected for the ward shall be the number specified in respect of the ward in column (3) of that Schedule 1.

### Alteration of parish areas and the areas of parish wards

12. Each area coloured and designated by a letter on the map shall cease to be part of the parish and where applicable ward of that parish and shall become part of the parish and where applicable, parish ward of that parish specified in relation to that area in columns (2) and (3) of the Schedule 2 and Schedule 3 and shall become part of the parish and parish ward specified in relation to that area in columns (4) and (5) of those Schedules.

#### Electoral register

**13.** The registration officer for the district shall make such rearrangement of, or adaptation of, the register of local government electors as may be necessary for the purposes of, and in consequence of, this Order.

### Transfer of property, rights and liabilities (b)

**14.** The land, property, rights and liabilities described in Schedules 4, 5, 6 and 7 shall transfer on the date specified in column (2) of those Schedules.

#### Order date

**15.** The first of April 2015 is the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) (England) Regulations 2008 (a).

### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Warwick District Council for the alteration of the areas of the parish councils for Ashow and Stoneleigh, Barford, Sherbourne and Wasperton, Bishop's Tachbrook, Budbrooke, Burton Green, Kenilworth, Leek Wootton and Guys Cliffe, Old Milverton and Blackdown, Royal Learnington Spa, Warwick and Whitnash within the district of Warwick.

The electoral arrangements apply in respect of parish elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors on Thursday 7 May, 2015.

Article 6 specifies the numbers of parish councillors for the Kenilworth Abbey ward.

Article 7 and the map establish the names and areas of the wards of the parish of Burton Green and the numbers of councillors for each ward.

Article 8 and the map establish the names and areas of the wards of the parish of Old Milverton and Blackdown and the numbers of councillors for each ward.

Article 9 and the map establish the names and areas of the wards of the parish of Royal Learnington Spa and the numbers of councillors for each ward.

Article 10 and the map establish the names and areas of the wards of the parish of Warwick and the numbers of councillors for each ward.

Article 11 provides for the abolition of Queens ward of the parish of Kenilworth.

Article 12 provides for alterations to parish areas.

Article 13 obliges the Electoral Registration Officer to make any necessary amendments to the electoral register to reflect the new electoral arrangements.

The map defined in article 2 shows the alterations to parishes. It is available for inspection during normal working hours at the offices of Warwick District Council, Riverside House, Milverton Hill, Royal Learnington Spa, Warwickshire CV32 5HZ.
