### Warwick District Local Plan

Revised Development Strategy: Consultation June/ July 2013

Sets out revised locations for development –

- South of Warwick, Leamington & Whitnash,
- East of Kenilworth, and
- Limited development in the larger villages

Consultation underway until 29<sup>th</sup> July

Draft Local Plan likely to be published at the end of 2013/ early 2014

## **HMO Policy**

Policy Development:

- Draft Policy to Executive tomorrow for approval as a basis for public consultation
- Consultation will commence early July for a period of 6 weeks
- Following analysis of responses, the Policy will be amended and returned to Executive for approval as an Interim Policy
- Policy will be incorporated into Draft Local Plan
- Details will be emailed to Landlords

### **HMO** Policy

Scope of the Policy:

- Policy applicable to HMOs including all student accommodation.
- Policy applicable to changes of use from dwellings to Class C4 uses in Learnington Spa only (in line with the Article 4 Direction)

## **HMO Policy**

HMO Policy as recommended to Executive:

- Proportion of dwellings in HMO use within 100m radius should not exceed 10% total dwellings (exceptions may be made in mixed use areas on main throughfares)
- Within 400m walking distance of a bus stop
- Adequate provision for storage of refuse containers

# Determining Applications Prior to Final Approval of HMO Policy

Applications will continue to be considered in relation to existing Local Plan policies, particularly in relation to:

- residential amenity, of future occupants and occupiers of neighbouring dwellings
- renewable energy
- refuse storage and collection
- car parking
- open space

### Determining Applications Prior to Final Approval of HMO Policy

However, the evidence base for the HMO Policy may be taken into account as a material planning consideration, particularly in relation to issues around the concentration of HMOs

### Update on Applications for C4 Uses

Since 1<sup>st</sup> April 2012, 11 applications have been received for changes of use from C3 to C4.

Of these, 8 were approved, 2 were refused and 1 is yet to be determined.

1 application was refused on over concentration issues.

1 application was refused on parking issues.
