Campion Hills.



This footpath through the Campion Hills links the school on Upper Holly Walk with Lillington and Leicester Street into Leamington town centre. This photo shows what the path was like before the work started.

This next photo is an example of what work was involved to create the new dual use footpath and cycleway.



This photo shows what the path now looks like, including all direction signs, pedestrian and cyclists signs. The path is now also lit after dark.

Castle Farm

The path at Castle Farm was a link between Abbey fields and the Castle Farm Leisure Centre, including the Children's Play area. This path was well used and in need of repair.



In order to accommodate pedestrians, cyclists and wheelchair users to meet the Governments requirements, the path needed to be made wider. This photo is an example of what was done to achieve this.

The finished path now looks much tidier and is used by a variety of users. There are still some minor works to be done before this project is complete. This includes the removal of the chicane at the Borrowell Lane end and the installation of a pedestrian guardrail on the pavement to prevent cyclists and pedestrians stepping straight out onto the road.
