

**Matter 7C Written Statement – H43 Kings Hill Lane – Mr & Mrs Barker
(1844)**

Dear Sir

We wish to protest most strongly about the proposal to build on Green Belt land at Kings Hill. To close the gap between Coventry and Kenilworth cannot, sensibly, be justified and is not wanted by either.

The loss of productive farmland is itself foolish and the area is not suitable, in any event, to support what is proposed.

The sewage system in this area is already running at nearing its maximum capacity and from the point of view of traffic the Finham Triangle does not lend itself to any further increase in traffic flow.

The environmental case also supports the retention of the Green Belt. There is no sensible case for further urban sprawl and when you look at the likely consequences of the latest madness of Coventry choosing to link itself with Birmingham and others the Midlands is going to be an even bigger mess than it has already become.
