# Matter 3: Housing Supply Note on Revisions to Policy DS7

# 12<sup>th</sup> December 2016

#### **Background**

- At the Local Plan Examination hearings on 29thg and 30<sup>th</sup> November issues relating to the supply of housing were discussed. Arising from these discussions, the Council agreed to revisit the wording of a number of its policies to clarify its position
- 2 This note sets out the Policy revisions proposed by the Council as a result of these discussions.
- 3 In particular, the revisions seek to address
  - a. the reference to "windfalls" in Policy DS7 which currently suggests windfalls are expected to be included from April 2015.
  - b. The expected amount of supply arising from each source is amended to reflect the latest housing trajectory (12<sup>th</sup> December 2016)

### Policy DS7

Policy DS7 sets out and quantifies the main sources of housing supply during the Plan Period. The estimated number of dwellings arising from each source of supply is inevitably sensitive to amendments to the Housing Trajectory. The table below therefore reflects the housing trajectory put forward by the Council on 12<sup>th</sup> December 2016. However, this is still subject to further change depending on the Inspector's findings.

In addition to amending the figures for each source of supply, the table below also clarifies that the windfalls allowances only includes a supply from windfalls from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2019.

As a result, (building on the amendments proposed in January 2016) it is proposed to amend Policy DS7 as follows:

## **DS7 Meeting the Housing Requirement**

The housing requirement of 16,766 new homes between 2011 and 2029 will be met from the following categories:
