Submissions

- The submissions are similar to Discharge of Conditions.
- Timetable- We have been told by HS2 to expect to receive the first submission in February 2017
- Over the next three years HS2 anticipate that they will be making over 100 submissions to WDC

What Will the Submissions Cover?

Currently such things as:-

- Buildings, bridges, viaducts, kiosks
- Earth works, screening /noise bunds
- Watercourse diversions
- Materials Storage sites

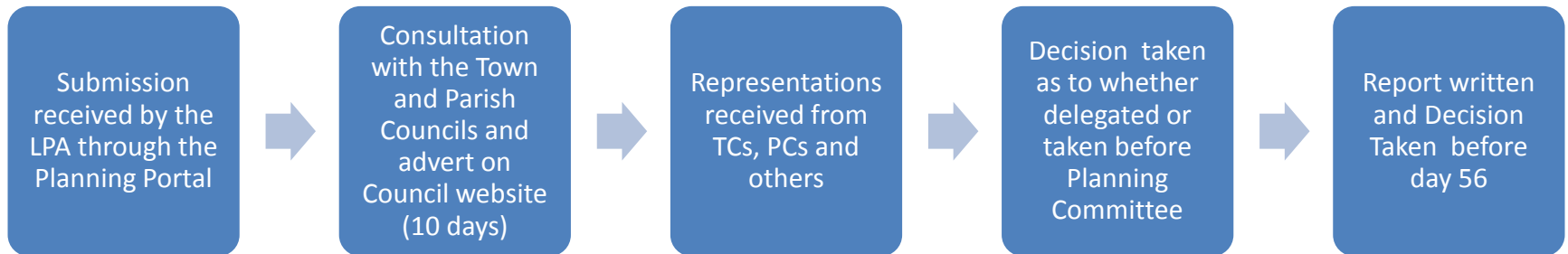
What Are the Factors that the Council will be able to Consider?

- Visual Appearance
- Materials and finishes
- Landscaping

What are the Factors that the Council Won't be Able to Consider?

- The principle of the scheme
- Noise
- Traffic issues?
- Anything other than the specific factors that we can take into account

The Process



Deciding what needs to go to Planning Committee – Cllr John Cooke

- The Head of Development Services to determine all applications submitted to Warwick District Council, with the exception of the following:-
- Any application which raises significant issues and public interest such that in the opinion of the Head of Development Services, in consultation with the Chair and Vice Chair of Planning Committee should be referred to Planning Committee

Responding to Consultations

- What you should cover – stick to specific considerations
- Timescales for Response - 10 days
- Do you need to organise yourselves differently?

- Don't forget, you cannot object to the principle of the railway.
- Meet Regularly
- Submit Promptly
- Comments need to be brief and confined to appropriate subjects.
