WDC Matter 3 Submission - Note on Application W/15/0531: University of Warwick

- 1. At the Matter 3 hearings on 29th and 30th November, the housing trajectory was discussed, including dwellings associated with student accommodation at the University of Warwick (application number W/15/0531).
- 2. In the trajectory that formed the basis of the discussions at that session (November 2016), this application was indicated to account for 167 dwellings. However, there was a lack of clarity as to how this figure had been arrived at and the Council agreed to check the application in detail and provide a note to clarify.
- Application W/15/0531 is described as: Submission of details of all Reserved Matters under Condition 1 (in part, as it relates to proposed halls of residence, Scarman Road); imposed on planning permission reference W/07/ 1120 granted on the 12th October 2009 for development for university purposes.
- 4. Specifically the application is for Sherbourne Phase 2 and comprises 273 student beds, plus 6 self-contained flats for staff.
- 5. The Council assumes each student bedspace will release 1 dwelling to the mainstream market (on the basis that HESA shows that the University has been more or less static in terms of numbers of full time students since 2011).
- 6. On this basis, 273 student bedspaces equates to 68 dwellings. In addition the proposal include 6 self contined flats. Therefore the total amount of dwellings accounted for from application W/15/0531 should be 74. This is shown in the updated trajectory (EXAM 147)
- 7. It is not entirely clear how the original figure of 167 dwellings was arrived at, but it appears that it is based on an assumption that Sherbourne Phase 2 was providing the same amount of accommodation as Sherbourne Phase 1. Whereas, in reality Sherbourne Phase 1 is more than twice the size of Phase 2.
- 8. It should be noted that application W/15/0531 is currently under construction. This will be reflected in the monitoring update to be undertaken in January 2017.
