High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty Vinci is working on behalf of HS2 Ltd to build the new high speed railway in your area.

What work will we be doing?


We will be undertaking ground investigation surveys which will help us to finalise the detail design for the route to be constructed. The surveys will involve taking soil samples and bore holes in fields.

When will these works take place?

Working in line with the land owner's requests, the ground investigations are planned to take place from April 2019 and will take around 7 weeks to complete.

Where will the surveys be taking place?

The survey works will take place in multiple field locations adjacent to the Rugby Road near Cubbington.

- The work is planned to start during April 2019
- It will take approximately 7 weeks
- Our working hours will be Monday – Friday from 08:00-18:00.
- We do not have any plans to carry out work on Saturday or Sunday.

- We will install temporary work sites such as fencing and/or hoardings.
