Long Itchington Wood Tunnel Utilities - Phase 1 and 2

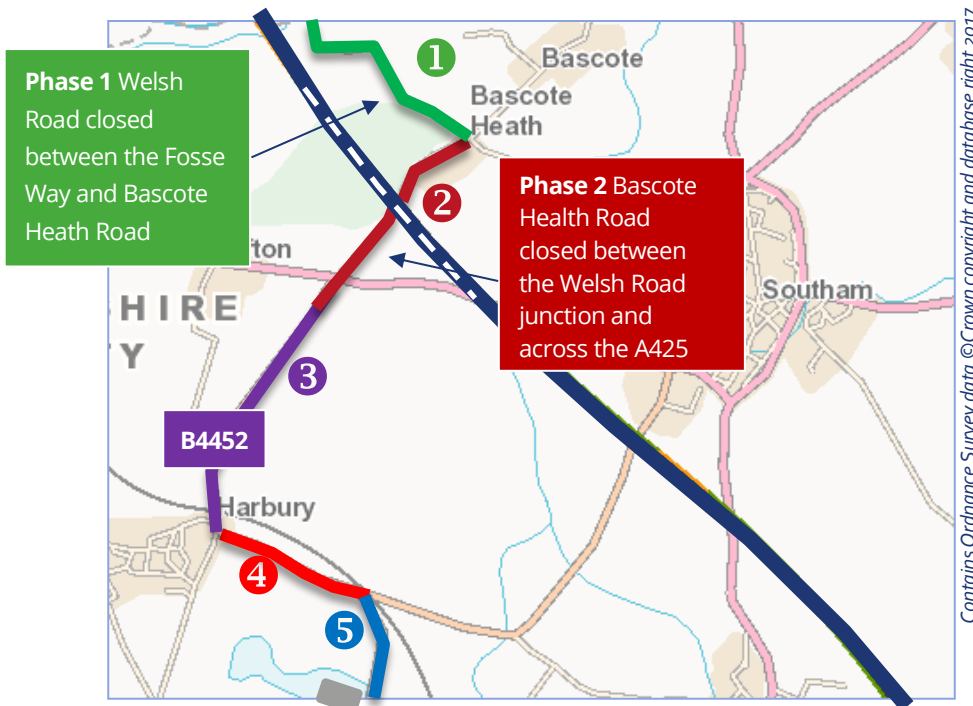
High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Initial works have now started and are carried out by LM – a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons.

We will be continuing our works to install utilities including power, telecoms and water to the tunnel compound from Harbury substation. The next round of works will involve the excavation of jointing pits within the carriageway.

Phase 1 of 5 starts on 13th February to 9th March where Welsh Road will be closed between the Fosse Way and Bascote Heath Road. **Phase 2 starts soon after on 17th February until 14th April** between Bascote Heath Road past the A425 junction (please see map below). Dates are subject to change.

Please note. Both roads will be closed between 17th February to 9th March due to the locations where cables need to be installed. **However, access will still be maintained for households and businesses along both routes and a clearly signposted diversion will be in place.**

Duration of works

Phase 1 and 2 13th February to 14th April 2020.

Full road closure 24/7, seven days a week with working hours 8.00am to 6.00pm, subject to site and weather conditions.

Our contractors may also be on site for up to one hour beforehand and after to set up and pack up.

What to expect

Some noise from on site machinery during working hours.

Maintained access for emergency services and to properties and businesses along the route.
