Notice of pipeline diversion works near Dalehouse Lane, Kenilworth

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. To facilitate HS2's construction and to continue to ensure a safe and reliable gas supply, Cadent needs to move an existing gas pipeline south of Dalehouse Lane, Kenilworth.

We will be starting main work to move this pipeline in April 2020 and expect our work to be completed by the end of 2020. We will keep people up to date as our works progress.

What are we doing?

Before we start work to move the pipeline, we need to remove some vegetation on land either side of A46, south of Dalehouse Lane, starting in mid-February 2020.

We look to avoid removing vegetation wherever possible. In this case, we cannot divert the pipeline without doing this. We have carried out an assessment to minimise the amount of vegetation that will be removed.

Appropriate ecological surveys have been undertaken prior to any vegetation clearance being carried out, and our ecologist will be present throughout the activity to ensure there is no disruption to birds and local wildlife.

Our working area is on both sides of the A46. Construction vehicles will access the site from Dalehouse Lane and B4115.

How will this impact you?

All clearance works will be undertaken using standard industry methods. This means there may be some noise as we carry out the work, however, this will only be for a few hours.

The vegetation clearance will take place within our normal working hours.

Duration of vegetation clearance work

- Mid-February 2020 until the end of March 2020
- Our core working hours will be 8.00am to 6.00pm (Mon-Fri) and 8.00am to 1.00pm (Sat)
- We will be on-site one hour either side of these times for set-up and close-down

What to expect

- Removal of vegetation on land south of Dalehouse Lane and south of A46, near Kenilworth
- Construction vehicles will not access the working area from A46
- All work will be carried out within our normal working hours

What we will do

- Keep all sites safe and secure
- Inform people in advance of any changes
