## Notice of traffic management on B4115

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Early works for HS2 are carried out by LM – a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons.

### Works planned near Stoneleigh Park

You may have seen us working near Stoneleigh Park to prepare the route of the new railway. This work includes hedgerow and tree clearance to enable access to our ecological mitigation site in the area.

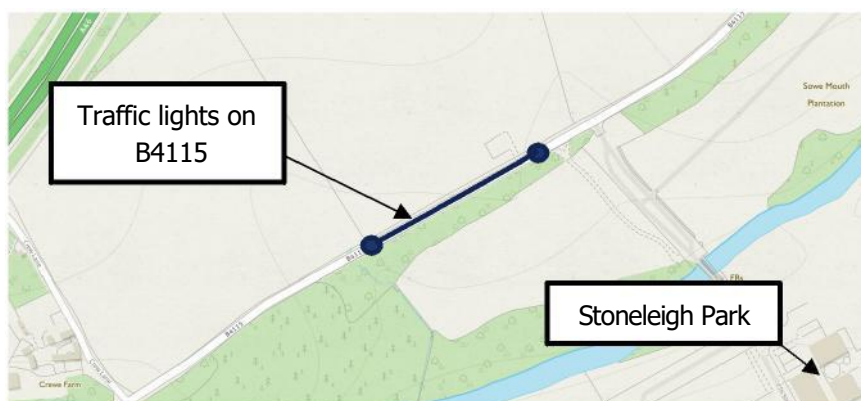
### There will be temporary traffic management

To ensure a safe access to roadside trees we will be operating temporary traffic lights along the B4115 near our existing compound. These signals will be operational during the week of Monday **20 April** between **9:30am to 3:30pm**. The traffic lights will be removed before we temporarily close the B4115 as previously notified. Our teams will be on site one hour before and one hour after the works to set up and secure the site at the end of each day.

Marshalls will escort pedestrians safely through the works as required.

### Why we're doing this work

We need to prepare as much of the route as possible over the coming months. This will ensure that our main construction work can commence on time.
