Temporary traffic lights - Burton Green

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Early works for HS2 are now underway in your area, carried out by LM – a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons.

LM will be creating two temporary accesses to facilitate the construction of the approved Kenilworth Greenway diversion in Burton Green. From **Monday 20 April, three-way temporary traffic lights with a lane closure will be installed on Hob Lane for one week**, to create the first access point.

Following works on Hob Lane, **two-way traffic lights with a lane closure will be installed on Red Lane around Monday 27th April for one week**, to create the second access point (please see map below).

Four-way traffic lights will then be installed on Hob Lane from 4th May for up-to twelve weeks to allow HS2 construction traffic in and out of the access point. **Please note these are temporary construction accesses and NOT the permanent crossing designs.** All works are subject to consent, site and weather conditions. Dates are also subject to change.



We are continually reviewing the works on our construction sites in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with COVID-19. The Government's current COVID-19 strategy makes clear that construction activity can continue as long as it complies with this guidance.

The health and safety of our workforce and the communities we affect is our key priority. Please be assured that those sites that are currently still working are doing so because they can operate within PHE and construction industry guidelines.
