The Forward Plan is a list of all the Key Decisions which will be taken by the Cabinet up to the next twelve months. The Warwick District Council definition of a key decision is: a decision which has a significant impact or effect on two or more Wards and/or a budgetary effect of £50,000 or more.

This is because the agenda and reports for the meeting will contain exempt information under Part 1 of Schedule 12A to the Local Government Act 1972 (as amended) and that the public interest in withholding the information outweighs the public interest in disclosing it. Those items which are proposed to be considered in private are marked as such along with the reason for the exclusion in the list below.
