The series of Byelaws made by the Warwick District Council with respect to pleasure grounds on 18th April, 1977 and confirmed by the Secretary of State on 23rd June, 1977 is hereby extended to include Extension to Sydenham Play Area, Leamington Spa; Gainsborough Drive Amenities Area, Leamington Spa; and Streamside Off Danesbury Crescent, Leamington Spa, which names shall be added to Part 1 of Schedule A of the aforesaid series, which shall be read and construed accordingly
