AN AMENDING BYELAW



BYELAWS for the Good Rule and Government of the District of Warwick and for the Prevention of Nuisance made by the Warwick District Council in pursuance of Section 235 of the Local Government Act 1972.

1. The Byelaws made by the Warwick District Council on 25th July 1985 and confirmed by the Secretary of State on 10th September 1985 are hereby amended by the addition of the following Byelaw and the said Byelaws shall be read and construed accordingly:-

“8A. No person shall urinate or defecate in any street or public place.”
