AN AMENDING BYELAW

relating to

THE DELL GARDENS PLAY AREA

made on 11th November 1985



BYELAWS made under Section 164 of the Public Health Act 1875, Section 15 of the Open Spaces Act 1906, Sections 12 and 15 of the Open Spaces Act 1906, and Section 19(1) of the Warwick Corporation Act 1948 by the Warwick District Council with respect to pleasure grounds.

1. The series of byelaws made by the Warwick District Council with respect to pleasure grounds on 18th April 1977 and confirmed by the Secretary of State on 23rd June 1977 is hereby extended as follows:-

Byelaw 20

The provision of this byelaw shall be extended to apply to the pleasure ground known as Dell Gardens play area, Leamington Spa which name shall be added to Schedule B of the aforesaid series.
