

**WARWICK DISTRICT COUNCIL (Off Street Parking Places) ORDER 2025**  
**NOTICE OF PROPOSALS**

WARWICK DISTRICT COUNCIL ("the Council") gives notice that it proposes to make the above Order in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), the Traffic Management Act 2004 as amended and the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 (SI 1996/2489) and all other enabling powers.

The Proposed Order relates to existing off-street parking places provided by the Council at the locations listed in the Schedule of Parking Places and Charges below and is intended to come into operation on 00.01 hours on 1<sup>st</sup> April 2025 (or as soon as possible thereafter).

The Council intend to revoke the Warwick District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2020 and subsequent Notices of Variation of Charges dated 3<sup>rd</sup> January 2022, 3<sup>rd</sup> January 2023 and 3<sup>rd</sup> January 2024 in their entirety.

The proposed new order will revoke the aforementioned 2020 Order and Notices of Variation and will make the following changes to the conditions, use, charges and periods of parking at Council Off Street Car Parks:

1. Increase the fees and charges to all Warwick District Council (WDC) Car Parks, with a reduction in charges at Hampton Road Car Park.

- Introduce a new tariff for 24 hours' parking in all relevant long stay car parks and to reduce the current 'All Day' tariff to stay up to 10 hours in all long stay car parks except Old Town Car Parks in Leamington Spa, where the 'All Day' tariff will allow a stay of up to 11 hours (Bath Place, Court Street, Packington Place, Station Approach and Station Approach Lower Road Car Parks).
- Introduce new and revised terms of use surrounding the use of Electric Vehicle Charging Bays and Charge Points.
- Include reference to 'electronic Season Tickets' in its T&Cs Part III Season Tickets.
- Increase Special Event charges to £10 across all WDC Car Parks, to align with current standard budget increases.

6. Increase the fees to secure the release of vehicles from Multi Storey Car Parks (MSCP) to £69, to align with current standard budget increases.
7. Increase the charge for skips and scaffolding to be placed on car parks to £69 per day and £265 per week, to align with current standard budget increases.
8. Increase the admin charge in connection with lost or damaged Season Tickets, Overnight Permits, Resident's Overnight Permits, Royal Spa Permits and Electric Vehicle Permits to £8, to align with current standard budget increases.
9. Formally designate St Peter's MSCP as a Pay and Display (pay by phone) Car Park.
10. Separate the Car Park currently designated as 'Station Approach (Surface and Roadway)' which includes both the Surface Car Park and the Roadway Parking, into two distinct parking areas with a Lower Road addition to the name of one.
11. Allow Season Tickets provision at the Station Approach Car Park and Station Approach Lower Road Car Park in line with Old Town charges.
12. Rename the Car Park known as Newbold Comyn Car Parks (Leisure centre, Football Pitch and off Wills Road) Leamington Spa to Newbold Comyn Car Parks (Leisure Centre, off Newbold Terrace East and Football Pitches) Leamington Spa.
13. Introduce enforcement powers in relation to the existing parking restriction areas within the Housing Westbrook House residential complex off the adopted highway.
14. Remove the Riverside House, Upper Grove Street and Royal Priors Multi-Storey car parks in Leamington Spa and the Barrack Street Multi-Storey car park in Warwick from the Parking Order.
15. Introduce parking restrictions and enforcement into the Parking Order for:
  - a) the Leamington Spa Town Hall front service lane and adjoining pedestrian area (fronting the building);
  - b) the Radford Road Car Park (a free of charges car park).
16. Include West Street Car Park (a free of charges Car Park) and Oakley Grove School Car Park, Oakley Wood Rd, Bishops Tachbrook, Leamington (Long Stay) in the Parking Order.
17. Clarify the terms for 0 to 2 hours' free parking at Bread and Meat Close and Abbey Fields Car Parks (Available between 06:00 and 22:00 Monday to Sunday inclusive and only if the correct vehicle registration number is entered into the ticket machine, with no return for additional free parking within 12 hours).
18. Introduce 0 to 2 hours free parking and reduce the 24 hours parking charge in Hampton Road (Surface) Car Park. The same terms to obtain free parking as to the Bread and Meat Close and Abbey Fields car parks will apply.
19. Clarify the New Street (Surface) Car Park and West Gate (Surface) Car Park short stay maximum stay duration as being 4 hours.
20. Remove enforcement obligations for Humphries Street and Weston Close Housing parking areas.
21. Clarify the permitted parking schedule for vehicles using Cocksparrow Street Housing Area car park does not include WCC on-street parking permits in addition to the existing Council tenant permit holders.
22. Define the area of the Parking Place Myton Fields Picnic Area, (Long Stay) (Weather Permitting) that is operational between 1<sup>st</sup> April and 1<sup>st</sup> November each year, weather permitting and the overflow field reserved for authorised vehicles only for events and for recognised angling groups with Green Spaces permission during the fishing season with a valid licence and permit.
23. Introduce Special Event Charging at Abbey Fields Car Park.
24. Introduce a car park layout and capacities at Castle Farm Leisure Centre following its redevelopment.
25. Amend the eligible properties list for Abbey Fields resident permits.
26. Introduce to the Parking Order, a 2-hour maximum free parking stay and no return in 4 hours at Oakley Woods Crematorium, Bishops Tachbrook, Leamington Spa (Short Stay).

Full details of the proposals are contained in the draft Order, which may be seen, together with a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order and copies of the existing Order at the Council's principal office at the Royal Pump Rooms, Parade, Royal Leamington Spa, CV32 4AA between the hours of 09:30 and 16:30 Monday to Friday (excluding bank holidays and public holidays).
