Schedule of Variation for Budbrooke Service South, Southbound Service Area, A46 Warwick By-pass, Warwick

Authorisation No. 47

Schedule 1

1. The front page of the authorisation has been altered and the description of the process has been changed to include "as defined in Part B of Section 1.4 of Schedule 1 to the Environmental Protection (Prescribed Processes and Substances) Regulations 1991, SI 472, as amended.

The process is to be operated within the process boundary marked on the attached location map A, boundary plan B and site plan C, as defined in the following conditions. The service station has five storage tanks."

2. The wording of condition 3 has changed from "Warwick District Council shall be advised" to "Warwick District Council Environmental Health (See explanatory note 12) shall be advised".
3. The following sentence has been removed from condition 25 "The log book shall also detail any suspected vapour leak together with action taken to deal with any leak, in accordance with conditions 3, 4 and 5."
4. To take account of the above changes the authorisation Ref. No.47 has been withdrawn and replaced by authorisation Ref. No.47/1, a copy of which is attached.
