Leamington Spa Art Gallery and Museum's biennial Open exhibition will be taking place this year from 15 May – 12 July, showcasing selected works from artists based in the West Midlands which have been chosen by an independent panel of judges: Wendy Law, **Director Turning Point West Midlands**, Peter McCarthy, Artist and Critic and Fiona Venables, Deputy Curator Mead Gallery.

> The winner of the People's Choice award, which will be announced on Friday 3 July, will receive £500.

When do I need to submit my work?

Eligibility

Artists are invited to submit a maximum of two pieces of work on Thursday 7 May between 10.30am - 7pm. An admission fee of £5.00 per work will be charged for the submitted work(s).

The exhibition will be open to the public 15 May - 12 July 2015

The exhibition will take place in the temporary exhibitions gallery at Learnington Spa Art Gallery and Museum, CV32 4AA.

To qualify for entry, you must be an artist or maker over 18 years of age, living, working or studying in the West Midlands region which comprises: Herefordshire, Shropshire, Staffordshire, Warwickshire, Worcestershire and the Metropolitan Districts of Birmingham, Coventry, Dudley, Sandwell, Solihull, Walsall and Wolverhampton. Anyone can enter

Work must have been completed after 1 January 2014.



**Entries** Selected works must be available for inclusion in the exhibition from Thursday 7 May – Tuesday 14 July 2015.

## All works must be for sale.

Two dimensional work should not exceed  $3m(h) \times 2m(w)$ Three dimensional work should not exceed  $2 \times 2 \times 2 m$ 

All two dimensional work must be mirror plated

All electronically powered works must have been PAT tested.
