Can you **create your own design** for the frame?

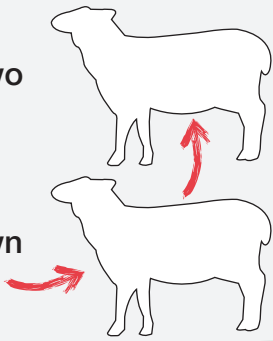

Count **how many sheep** there are in each and write down the answers here.

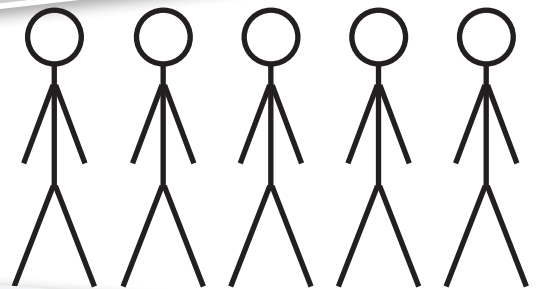
