NEW SCHOOLS WORKSHOP PROGRAMME AUTUMN 2016!

Leamington Spa Art Gallery & Museum is offering a new schools programme for Autumn 2016. Arts Award – Discover in a Day has been designed for pupils in KS1 and KS2 and is a great opportunity to enhance your pupils' arts education in a fun and engaging way.

Pupils can take part in a day of arts activities, exploring both the Art Gallery and the Museum. At the end of the session they will gain a nationally recognised qualification from Trinity College London in association with Arts Council England, with each child receiving a certificate on completion.



What is included in Arts Award – Discover in a Day?

- Pre and post visit activity resources
- Sixty minute self-led trail around the Museum
- Ninety minute art workshop in the Art Gallery & Craft Studio
- Assessment of work by trained advisers
- Arts Award Discover certificates
- Links to the National Curriculum





CHOOSE ONE OF THE FOLLOWING ART WORKSHOPS:

EVERY PICTURE TELLS A STORY

Pupils will explore artwork dating from the 17th century to the modern day, work in teams to create storyboards and props, learn about the process of stop motion animation and develop the skills to create their own film to use back in the classroom.

PORTRAIT PRINTS

Pupils will explore portrait paintings from the 19th, 20th and 21st centuries, looking at how the face and expression have been depicted. They will develop their drawing skills and create their own monoprints.

To prepare your pupils for the Arts Award – Discover in a Day we will provide worksheets and resources. Arts Award resources include a short film and song about the art all around us. The classroom activities will get children thinking about all the different types of art that they already know and like, and can see or find.
