


Make your own elephant tiles!


In Leamington you may notice there are pictures and statues of elephants everywhere! We thought it would be fun to bring you an elephant themed craft for you to enjoy at home.

- You will need:**
- Clay, play dough or salt dough**
(visit our YouTube channel to find an easy recipe about how to make your very own salt dough with just three ingredients)
 - Scissors**
(please ask an adult to help you)
 - A rolling pin and various tools**
including a plastic knife and things to make patterns, like a felt tip lid or old pencil

1 Draw and cut out an elephant template.



2 Squeeze the clay into a flat shape and then roll out so it's about the thickness of a pound coin.




3 Put your template onto the clay and draw around it with a pencil. Ask an adult to cut out the shape with a knife.

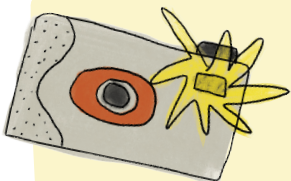
4 Now decorate your elephant tile with any patterns you like.






5 You could add some colour with poster paint.



6 Display your tiles on a mantelpiece or windowsill at home.
